Separate SEALED BIDS for the: furnishing all labor and materials and performing all work necessary for construction of Contract No. 1 – Wells No. 4 & 5 and Contract No. 2 – 20” Raw Water Line will be received by the Ada Public Works Authority/City of Ada at the **Purchasing Office located 512 N. Stockton, Ada, OK 74820, until 1:30 p.m. local time on the 27th day of September 2019.**

The sealed bids will be opened and read aloud at the City of Ada West Annex, 210 West 13th Street (West Annex Door) Ada, OK 74820 on September 27, 2019 at 2:00 p.m. local time.

The contracts will be awarded separately. Bidders may bid Contract No. 1, Contract No. 2 or Contracts No. 1 and 2. Bidders must bid on all items in the bid form. The work under each contract will be awarded as a single contract to the lowest responsible bidder for the work. No bid may be withdrawn for at least sixty (60) days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.

All checks shall be made payable to Holloway, Updike & Bellen. Each proposal must be accompanied by a Bidder's Bond, or Cashier's Check upon any solvent Bank or Trust Company, payable without reserve to the Ada Public Works Authority, Ada, Oklahoma, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid. Bid security of the two low bidders will be retained until approval of contract and execution of satisfactory bonds by the successful bidder, or until other disposition on the bids is made.

BIDDER must purchase plans and specifications from Holloway, Updike and Bellen, Inc. either directly for a hard copy of bidding documents or through Quest CDN for an electronic copy. Bidder must be on the Engineer's official plan holder's list in order to receive addendums and submit a bid.

The bonds required will be a Performance Bond, a Payment Bond, and a Maintenance Bond each in the full amount of the contract. The Authority will not accept letters of credit in lieu of any bond required herein.

All bids must comply with:

- Assurances that surety companies executing bonds appear on the Treasury Department's list and are authorized to transact business in the State where the project is located.

A **mandatory pre-bid** conference is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on September 20, 2019 in the City of Ada West Annex, 210 West 13th Street (West Annex Door), Ada, OK 74820. The bidder must supply all the information required by the bid and proposal form including completion of affidavits or his bid will be considered incomplete and therefore rejected.

The Owner may request of any bidder, before his bid is considered for award, that he submit a statement of facts as to his previous experience in performing work of the same character and magnitude, as to his business and technical organization, and financial resources and plant available and to be use in performing the contemplated work. Each bidder must have such information, together with a recent financial statement, available upon request.

This project is to be paid by local funds.

Contract to be awarded to low responsive responsible bidder. The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities in the bidding and the right to reject any and all bids in accordance with the Oklahoma Competitive Bidding Act. Conditional bids shall not be accepted.
