The Ada Public Works Authority met in regular session, Monday, August 5, 2019, at City Hall in the Dr. Ray L. Stout City Council Chamber immediately following the recessed meeting of the Ada City Council. Discussion of and action on items removed from the Consent Agenda

Discussion of and action on acceptance of bid from SCS Field Services for the Landfill Gas Cut-Off Trenches Project in the amount of \$887,828.00; approval of Notice of Award to SCS Field Services; authorization for Chairman to execute any and all necessary documents related to said Project, including, but not limited to, the Contract and Notice to Proceed, contingent upon Authority approval of Change Order No. 1 which reduces the Contract amount to \$393,880.00

Authority Manager Holcomb Authority Manager Holcomb reported sealed bids were accepted for gas cut-off trenches at the active and closed landfills on February 1st of this year. Mr.

Holcomb explained the project consists of trenches/vents to intercept methane gas and prevent the methane gas from migrating off the landfill sites.

Mr. Holcomb advised the low bid was presented by SCS Field Services in the amount of \$887,828.00. Mr. Holcomb stated the bid amount exceeds the available funds for this project.

City Engineer Gary Kinder addressed the Council, explaining he had coordinated with SCS Field Services to value engineer the project, which had resulted in a reduction of \$493,948.00 from the bid amount. Mr. Kinder explained the final contract amount, incorporating Change Order No. 1, will be \$393,880.00, and it is within the project budget.

Motion was made by **Trustee Sewell**, seconded by **Trustee McFarlane** to approve acceptance of the bid from SCS Field Services for the Landfill Gas Cut-Off Trenches Project in the amount of \$887,828.00; approval of Notice of Award to SCS Field Services; authorization for Chairman to execute any and all necessary documents related to said Project, including, but not limited to, the Contract and Notice to Proceed, contingent upon Authority approval of Change Order No. 1 which reduces the Contract amount to \$393,880.00. Chairman Landrum called for a vote taken with the following result:

Discussion of and action on approval of Change Order No. 1 to contract with SCS Field Services for the Landfill Gas Cut-Off Trenches Project, reducing the Contract in the amount of \$493,948.00; authorization for the Chairman to execute the Change Order No. 1 at a date to be determined

Authority Manager Holcomb explained Change Order No. 1 would allow the project to be brought to value engineered and bring it into budget. Mr. Holcomb stated value engineering eliminated the gas trench at the closed landfill and replaced it with vents. Value engineering at the open landfill removed the geomembrane and geotextile from the project. The Authority Manager again stated these changes reduced the contract amount of \$493,948.00, resulting in a revised contract amount of \$393,880.00, which is within the project budget.

Motion was made by **Trustee McFarlin**, seconded by **Trustee McFarlane** to approve Change Order No. 1 to contract with SCS Field Services for the Landfill Gas Cut-off Trenches Project, reducing the Contract in the amount of \$493,948.00; authorizing the Chairman to execute the Change Order No. 1 at a date to be determined. Chairman Landrum called for a vote taken with the following result:
