

**CITY OF ADA
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
APRIL 22, 2021**

The Ada City Council met in a special called meeting, Thursday, April 22, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. at the Ada City Hall, in the Dr. Ray L. Stout City Council Chamber. 231 S. Townsend. Notice of the special call meeting was recorded by the City Clerk on Tuesday, April 20, 2021 at 8:10 a.m. Advanced public notice was given by posting the agenda on the City Hall bulletin board on Wednesday, April 21, 2021 at 9:59 a.m.

The special called meeting of the Ada City Council was called to order by Vice Mayor Randy McFarlin.

Discussion and action on approval of Chickasaw Nation Law Enforcement Commission Agreement

City Attorney Frank Stout explained in December 2020, the City of Ada entered into a cross deputation agreement between the State of Oklahoma, Chickasaw Nation and Bureau of Indian Affairs, which allowed Ada Police Department officers to enforce certain federal laws on Tribal land. Mr. Stout informed the Council that agreement did not allow Ada Police Department Officers to enforce Tribal Laws on Tribal Land, but the Agreement in consideration for approval, would allow Ada Police Department Officers to do that by agreeing that the Chickasaw Nation can cross-commission the officers.

Motion was made by **Councilman Morris**, seconded by **Councilman Sewell** to approve Chickasaw Nation Law Enforcement Commission Agreement. Vice Mayor McFarlin called for a vote taken with the following result:

AYE: McFarlin, Morris, Sewell

NAY: None

Motion carried 3-0.

Discussion of and action on commitment to provide in-kind use of North Annex for Ada Job Foundation's application to the U. S. Economic Development Administration's Build to Scale Venture Challenge grant program for the Ada Technology Startup Sprint of Southern Oklahoma Project; authorization for City Manager to execute documents related thereto
