

**CITY OF ADA
REGULAR MEETING
OCTOBER 18, 2021**

The Ada City Council met in a regular meeting, Monday, October 18, 2021 at 5:45 p.m., at Ada City Hall, in the Dr. Ray L. Stout City Council Chamber, 231 S. Townsend. Advanced public notice was given by posting the agenda on the City Hall bulletin board on Friday, October 15, 2021 at 9:40 a.m., and posting on the City of Ada web site Friday, October 15, 2021.

The meeting of the Ada City Council was called to order by Mayor Tre' Landrum.

Mayor Landrum led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Landrum called for a moment of silence.

Mayor Landrum presented City of Ada pins to Boy Scout Troop No. 4 members that were in attendance at the council meeting.

City Manager Holcomb advised that city staff were preparing for the renewing of Proposition One and Two, to be on the February 2022 election ballot.
