Study session to discuss the scope and outcomes of upcoming Long Range (Comprehensive) Plan update

City Manager Cody Holcomb introduced the staff present from Halff Associates, Inc. Those addressing the Council were Brennan Kane, Carnell Brame, Jason Claunch, Ryan Short, and Shane Hampton.

Members of Halff Associates, a company specializing in city and district branding, public engagement, and destination marketing, working with communities to foster civic pride, attract talent, tourism, and investment through planning and economic development, provided a slide presentation for the meeting.

The Halff Associates explained a Comprehensive Plan was not a zoning or land use map but was a policy document that guides future growth and development, provides opportunity to set long-term community vision, a guide for amendments and changes to Zoning Ordinances, maps, and subdivision regulations.
